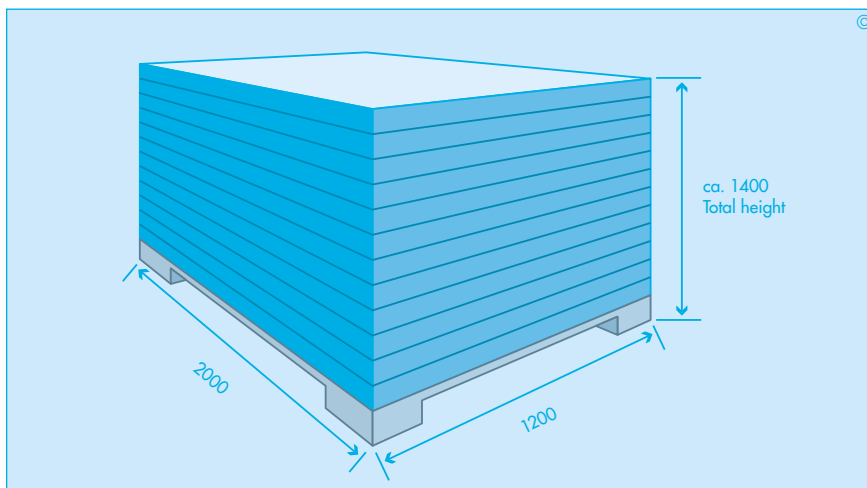

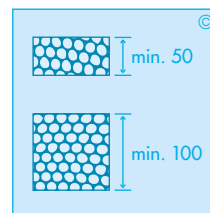
Laminated block foam made of high quality, physically crosslinked closed cell PO-roll foam.
